### Here is the summary:

- Web is limited to 4 sockets with a max of 16 cores vs standard which is 4 sockets with a max of 24 cores.
- Max memory supported for web is 64GB vs 128GB for standard
- Web can only be a witness in database mirroring
- No backup compression in web
- Web has no failover cluster instance or availability group support unlike standard which has some limited support.
- No row level security or data masking in web. It is in standard.
- No backup encryption in web either
- No service broker support in web
